For the State of Iowa

Since 1994, \$69,563,640 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Iowa

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 745 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Iowa.
- 244 local and state law enforcement agencies in Iowa have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$5,250,111 has been awarded to add 43 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Iowa.
- \$7,551,433 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Iowa fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
