For the State of Indiana

Since 1994, \$119,783,719 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Indiana

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 1,592 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Indiana.
- 279 local and state law enforcement agencies in Indiana have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$12,828,017 has been awarded to add 105 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Indiana.
- \$19,228,863 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Indiana fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
