For the State of Kentucky

Since 1994, \$113,687,913 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Kentucky

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 1,401 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Kentucky.
- 289 local and state law enforcement agencies in Kentucky have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$17,279,596 has been awarded to add 180 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Kentucky.
- \$28,133,431 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Kentucky fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
