For the State of Massachusetts

Since 1994, \$214,549,692 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Massachusetts

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 3,031 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Massachusetts.
- 352 local and state law enforcement agencies in Massachusetts have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$17,447,537 has been awarded to add 141 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Massachusetts.
- \$24,647,165 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Massachusetts fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
