For the State of Maine

Since 1994, \$40,565,422 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Maine

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 390 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Maine.
- 113 local and state law enforcement agencies in Maine have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$6,783,064 has been awarded to add 56 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Maine.
- \$5,539,367 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Maine fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
