## **For the State of Michigan**

Since 1994, \$222,009,480 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Michigan

### **Highlights**

- COPS grants have funded 3,371 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Michigan.
- 514 local and state law enforcement agencies in Michigan have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$19,275,838 has been awarded to add 156 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Michigan.
- \$48,503,833 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Michigan fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
