For the State of Minnesota

Since 1994, \$118,629,172 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Minnesota

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 1,424 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Minnesota.
- 364 local and state law enforcement agencies in Minnesota have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$10,586,400 has been awarded to add 88 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Minnesota.
- \$24,650,032 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Minnesota fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
