Since 1994, \$167,885,866 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Missouri

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 2,305 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Missouri.
- 457 local and state law enforcement agencies in Missouri have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$13,807,527 has been awarded to add 130 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Missouri.
- \$29,042,984 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Missouri fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
