For the State of North Carolina

Since 1994, \$175,112,634 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of North Carolina

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 2,934 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in North Carolina.
- 356 local and state law enforcement agencies in North Carolina have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$16,166,483 has been awarded to add 146 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout North Carolina.
- \$34,790,312 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of North Carolina fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
