For the State of North Dakota

Since 1994, \$26,391,289 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of North Dakota

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 272 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in North Dakota.
- 72 local and state law enforcement agencies in North Dakota have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$2,259,875 has been awarded to add 19 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout North Dakota.
- \$1,165,046 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of North Dakota fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
