For the State of New Hampshire

Since 1994, \$68,353,963 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of New Hampshire

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 525 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in New Hampshire.
- 151 local and state law enforcement agencies in New Hampshire have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$5,550,894 has been awarded to add 45 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout New Hampshire.
- \$39,043,311 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of New Hampshire fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
