For the State of New Jersey

Since 1994, \$344,142,459 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of New Jersey

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 4,806 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in New Jersey.
- 464 local and state law enforcement agencies in New Jersey have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$39,826,208 has been awarded to add 320 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout New Jersey.
- \$45,341,613 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of New Jersey fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
