

# ***COPS Quick Facts***

## **For the State of New York**

Since 1994, \$894,317,146 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of New York

### **Highlights**

- COPS grants have funded 11,927 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in New York.
- 398 local and state law enforcement agencies in New York have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$41,203,197 has been awarded to add 336 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout New York.
- \$73,039,265 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of New York fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
