For the State of Ohio

Since 1994, \$276,543,812 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Ohio

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 3,757 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Ohio.
- 644 local and state law enforcement agencies in Ohio have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$27,703,314 has been awarded to add 228 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Ohio.
- \$54,491,524 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Ohio fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
