## **For the State of Oklahoma**

Since 1994, \$86,511,688 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Oklahoma

### **Highlights**

- COPS grants have funded 1,059 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Oklahoma.
- 329 local and state law enforcement agencies in Oklahoma have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$11,952,005 has been awarded to add 129 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Oklahoma.
- \$7,984,400 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Oklahoma fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
