Since 1994, \$99,037,610 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Oregon

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 1,035 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Oregon.
- 171 local and state law enforcement agencies in Oregon have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$11,130,385 has been awarded to add 90 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Oregon.
- \$15,173,534 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Oregon fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
