For the State of Vermont

Since 1994, \$30,575,639 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Vermont

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 263 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Vermont.
- 64 local and state law enforcement agencies in Vermont have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$3,490,357 has been awarded to add 30 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Vermont.
- \$11,263,938 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Vermont fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
