For the State of Washington

Since 1994, \$186,539,312 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Washington

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 1,982 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Washington.
- 253 local and state law enforcement agencies in Washington have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$12,990,810 has been awarded to add 105 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Washington.
- \$20,257,710 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Washington fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
