For the State of Wisconsin

Since 1994, \$113,513,903 in COPS grants has been awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Wisconsin

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 1,353 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Wisconsin.
- 384 local and state law enforcement agencies in Wisconsin have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$10,610,289 has been awarded to add 85 school resource officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Wisconsin.
- \$21,740,912 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Wisconsin fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
