

# ***COPS Quick Facts***

**For the State of New Mexico**

To Date, \$75,015,685 in COPS grants were awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of New Mexico

## ***Highlights***

- COPS grants have funded 765 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in New Mexico.
- 109 local and state law enforcement agencies in New Mexico have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$8,917,218 has been awarded to add 82 school resources officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout New Mexico.
- \$8,118,369 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of New Mexico fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
