For the State of New Jersey

To Date, \$351,684,234 in COPS grants were awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of New Jersey

Highlights

- COPS grants have funded 4,800 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in New Jersey.
- 467 local and state law enforcement agencies in New Jersey have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$40,076,208 has been awarded to add 322 school resources officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout New Jersey.
- \$51,167,825 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of New Jersey fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
